Program Fee

The program fee is \$ 1,500, and includes:

- Accommodation with a local family,
- 3 meals daily,
- local registration and education activity costs,
- academic and administrative support,
- mandatory international health insurance fee,
- transfer from and to the airport,
- one full-day excursion,
- cultural activities.

The program fee does not include: round-trip international airfare, local transportation, UWF tuition (3 undergraduate-credit-hours), personal expenses for additional traveling, extra-curricular activities, and spending money.
